

The Bury and Sherbrooke sites are now accessible to citizens

Bury, Québec: The Régie intermunicipale du centre de valorisation des matières résiduelles du Haut-Saint-François et de Sherbrooke (Valoris) announces today that the transfer centre in Sherbrooke and the landfill site in Bury will once again be accessible to citizens as of Thursday, May 21. The arrival of the COVID-19 crisis has changed our lifestyles in just a few weeks and the accessibility of both our site has also been affected.

Valoris has closely followed the recommendations of Quebec's public health and with the arrival of a progressive deconfinement, it is now possible to restore access to the two sites belonging to the Régie while respecting certain rules guaranteeing the safety of citizens and employees. As of Thursday, citizens will be able to bring bulky items and waste to the Sherbrooke transfer centre and the Bury site.

New measures put in place :

- A maximum of 2 people is tolerated outside the car. Children must remain in the vehicle at all times;
- Citizens are responsible for unloading their cargo;
- You must not present any symptoms (fevers, coughs, etc.) to have access to the two sites;
- You must respect the instructions and remain courteous with the staff and other citizens;
- Only Interac debit card payments are accepted at both locations.

The landfill site in Bury will be open on Saturdays between 8:30 a.m. and noon starting May 23rd for the summer period. We invite you to consult our website and social networks to follow the evolution of this file.
